Dennis entered private practice in 1982 at DunnCox where he headed the firm's litigation department. While there, he appeared as an advocate in a wide range of matters in Jamaica. He was appointed Queen's Counsel in 1994. He has appeared before the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council on several occasions. Currently a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (FCI Arb), he also acted from time to time as sole arbitrator in various commercial and construction law disputes in Jamaica.

Since 1978 he has served the Norman Manley Law School as lecturer, Associate Tutor and course director. He occasionally served as an adjunct lecturer in the Faculty of Law at the University of the West Indies. Between 1998 and 2005, he was chairman of the Council of Legal Education.
